MURPHEY CANDLER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

The students at Murphey Candler are required to wear school uniforms everyday. There will be School Spirit days announced in advance where students will not have to wear uniforms. Otherwise, students must be in uniform upon the first day of attending Murphey Candler. Parents will be notified when students are out of uniform. Please see the consequences list below for uniform violations.

The basic uniform will consist of the following:

Girls

Khaki or navy pants, shorts, capris, or skirts Blue, white or gold polo style shirt with logo White, light blue or yellow blouse

Boys

Khaki or navy pants or shorts Blue, white, or gold, oxford or polo style shirt

*All pants must be appropriately sized. No baggy or sagging pants or shorts will be allowed. All pants must be worn at the waist. A belt is required for both boys and girls.
